REGISTRATION

- We are enrolling children aged 18 months through five years.
- The registration fee is \$50 per child.
- Registration fees must accompany the completed application for the enrollment to be official.
- The birth dates of two/three/four/five-year-olds must be on or before August 31.
- Each child's enrollment is expected for the full year.

LUNCH BUNCH

Children will have the option of staying for lunch from noon-1:00 PM for \$3 per day. (Parents provide lunch.)

REFUND POLICY

1. The registration fee is non-refundable.
2. The tuition is refundable only if the family moves out of Guilford County and the Day School is given four weeks written notice.
3. A refund check will be mailed to the new address.

WAITING LIST

A Waiting List begins as soon as a class becomes full. Priority on this list is as follows:

1. Church members over non-members who were not enrolled
2. Siblings of children who have attended St. Francis Day School

The Director may use discretion in balancing classes and will make final decisions on all class assignments.
